





HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS, FOR YOUR CHILDREN TO HAVE A SAFE HALLOWEEN.

PLEASE TAKE A RECENT CLOSE-UP PICTURE OF YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN

- 1. Make sure you know what your child is wearing, under their Halloween Costume.
- 2. Make sure you know the colors, or what details (if any) on their shirt/pants.
- 3. Make sure you know what type of shoes they have on and color.
- 4. Make sure you know, how their hair is styled; and what color (if dyed for Costume).
- 5. Make sure you know, what the costume they have on is, and also the color of costume.
- 6. Make sure if you aren't with them, that someone of age is with them. (Be sure that you know that persons first/last name and contact information).
- 7. Make sure your child/children, are with a group of children; NEVER ALONE!!!
- 8. Tell your child/children to NEVER give any information, to anyone if they are asked.
- 9. Make sure someone has a FULLY charged cell-phone with them, just in case they do run into trouble. Teach them how to dial 911.
- 10. Tell them where you want them to go, and tell them where NOT to go!
- 11. Tell them what time, you want them to be back at home.
- 12. Tell them NOT TO EAT ANY OF THE CANDY, until they have had it checked by you! THIS IS NON-NEGOTIABLE!!
- 13. Tell them never to go near a car, empty or occupied unless you or the adult in charge is with them
- 14. Teach your child to SCREAM NO!!!!! If someone tries to get them to go somewhere or take something other than a treat!
- 15. Be prepared with a flashlight and reflective gear for drivers who may not see you or children crossing the street. Light colors on costumes as well as glow sticks may also be helpful.
